

7 (a) See *Figure 7*.

(b) Average: $\frac{19.3 + 18.5 + 29.0 + 7.31 + 16.1 + 22.8 + 20.3}{7} \approx 19.0$; Median = 19.3;

Range = $29.0 - 7.31 \approx 21.7$. The average of the maximum elevations for the seven continents is 19,000 feet. About half of these continents have maximum elevations below 19,300 feet and about half are above. The largest difference between these elevations is 21,700 feet.

(c) The mountain with the highest elevation is Mount Everest in Asia.

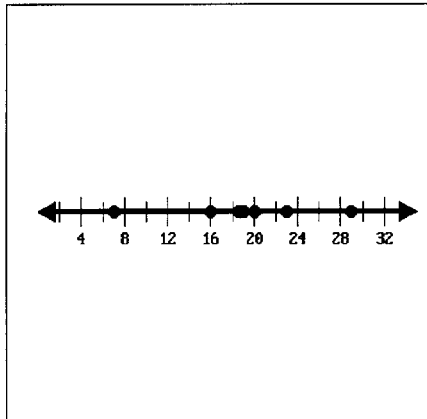
